Title	Description	Cost Estimate
Secure Bicycle Storage Area with Racks/Lockers	Provide an on-site storage area (~15 feet by 30 feet) for bicycles, skateboards and scooters. This would include a fenced lockable area with bicycle racks and skateboard/scooter lockers. It is estimated 54 bicycles and 24 skateboards/scooters could be secured in this facility. The location for this on-site storage area would be determined by the appropriate school/District administrators contingent on space available. NOTE: This project may require coordination with the Division of the State Architect. Cost estimates do not include any costs associated with coordination with other agencies.	Design Cost=\$5,000.00. Construction Cost including racks/lockers and chain link fencing = \$10,000.00. R-O-W Cost=None. Assumed storage area would be within school right-of-way.
Possible Installation of Protected Left-turn Signal Phasing at Tweedy Boulevard and State Street	Analysis of the need for protected left-turn phasing must be completed to determine if such signal timing is warranted at Tweedy Boulevard and State Street. If warranted, signal modification will be necessary.	Analysis Cost = \$3,000.00. Signal Modification Design Cost = \$5,000.00. Signal Modification Construction Cost = \$195,000.00
Alley Improvements for Pedestrians/Bicyclists	Future improvements in the alley north of Madison Elementary School should include consideration of school aged pedestrians and bicyclists.	Design Cost = Unknown. Construction Cost = Unknown.
School Zone and Speed Limit Signage	City of South Gate will provide appropriate school zone signage on State Street north of Tweedy Avenue.
